- Junior Membership - For future beef industry leaders between the ages of 0 - 18.

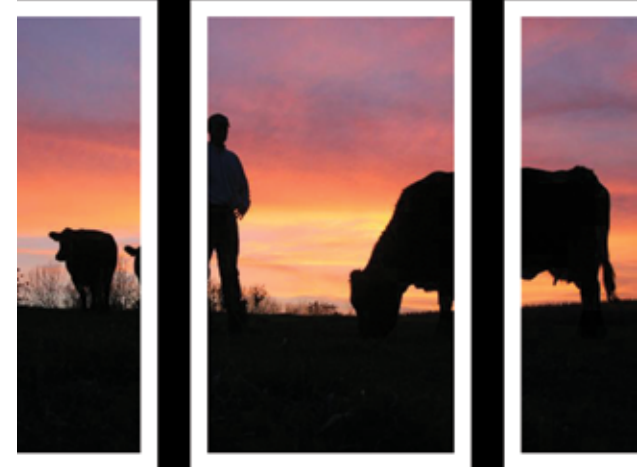
