- Commitment to engaging/uplifting others to create a foundation for their leadership activities.

## **PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

- 12 month program
- Required traveling to Denver and state-wide meetings.
- Meetings will be held in conjunction with CCA Mid-Winter Meetings and Annual Convention, a two-day session in Denver, and will be required to attend a Ranching Legacy Lectureship during the twelve-month period.
